Since 1972, the Trust has been working with the population of elephants in the Amboseli National Park in Kenya. It is the longest and most detailed study of free-living elephants, identifying and recording the life histories of more than 2,400 individuals. Their work has formed the basis of our present-day understanding of elephants, provides information critical to protecting elephants in the wild, and helps to define standards for humane treatment in captivity.

The Trust promotes elephant conservation through long-term research projects, training, community relations, public appreciation and advocacy. ElephantVoices is an affiliated project conducting research on elephant communication and acting as a voice for elephants and their interests.

Joyce Poole recently appeared in National Geographic’s Revenge of the Elephants. She has worked on behalf of elephants in captivity by providing testimony, expert statements and opinions, and making presentations before government bodies.
